How long will the tooth gem last?

Normally anywhere from 6 months up to 24 months for the Swarvoski Crystals and shaped crystals. 3 months-12 months for the real gold charms & real diamonds (due to extra weight on these specific charms)

Will the jewel harm my tooth?

No! The jewel is bonded to the enamel like an orthodontic bracket without any drilling or pain. The procedure and removal can be compared to the placement and removal of orthodontic brackets. When it is removed the tooth gem is simply popped off and the tooth will be polished to remove any remaining bonding material.

Can I still brush my teeth regularly?

Yes! The presence of the tooth gem will not make any difference regarding dental hygiene. However, it is recommended not to use an electric tooth brush.

What if the jewel falls off and I swallow it?

The Jewels are tiny glass crystals or gold. They have no sharp edges. It will basically come out "naturally"

Can I still have my teeth cleaned by my dentist?

Yes, you can and should still have your teeth cleaned by a professional. Tooth Jewelry will not cause a problem for the hygienist cleaning your teeth. The area underneath the jewel is sealed like a filling and will not let in any bacteria. The hygienist can easily polish on top and around the jewel with a soft point.
